COURSE OVERVIEW

The Second-Class Refrigeration Course is designed to help facilities train their staff to obtain a Second-Class Refrigeration ticket to continue to meet the Department of Labour and Advanced Education's codes and regulations.

Who needs this ticket?

Anyone who wants to be certified to operate:

- 1. Boilers
- 2. Refrigeration compressors
- 3. Air or other gas compressors

COURSE REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must have a minimum of grade 12 or their GED to register.

Applicants must also have 2000 hours in a licensed Refrigeration Plant prior to certification being awarded.

All mandatory in-class sessions must be attended, and the online component passed, before being able to take the final exam administered by the Department of Labour and Advanced Education Technical Safety Division.

COURSE SCHEDULE

The Second-Class Refrigeration course runs annually from January to June and includes:

- 1. Two-days of in-class, instructor led, orientation
- 2. Online training
- 3. Instructor-led review days once a month
- 4. Review week
- 5. Final Exam
