

Subject: Upcoming Aquatic Facility Survey – Nova Scotia Swimming Pool Infrastructure Study

Swim Nova Scotia, in partnership with the Recreation Facilities Association of Nova Scotia (RFANS) and with support from the Province of Nova Scotia, has launched a province-wide Swimming Pool Infrastructure Study to assess the current state and future needs of aquatic facilities. This important initiative, led by the consulting firm Aquatic Associates, will help inform the long-term planning, investment, and sustainability of aquatic infrastructure across Nova Scotia.
