We are pleased to announce that nominations are now open for the 2026 Recreation Facility Association of Nova Scotia (RFANS) Board of Directors. RFANS is seeking individuals who bring a balance of skills, experience and commitment to support the mission and strategic priorities of the Association. Ideal candidates demonstrate strong leadership and governance capabilities, particularly in areas pertinent to recreation facility management, operations and non-profit organizations.

The following positions will be up for election in 2026:

- President
- Vice-President
- Fundy Regional Representative
- Valley Regional Representative
- Central Regional Representative
- (1) Member at Large

All positions are for two-year terms and will end in 2028. Elections will be conducted at the RFANS Annual General Meeting on June 11th, 2026.

Any individual who is eighteen (18) years of age or older, who has the power under law to contract, and whose appointment is deemed to be of benefit to the Society may be nominated for election or appointment as a Director. Any member of the Society may nominate an individual to be one of the Directors of the Society, provided however that each member is limited to one (1) nomination per annum.

This is an exciting opportunity to recognize and engage individuals who demonstrate exceptional leadership, dedication, and commitment to our mission.

We invite you to submit nominations for candidates who:

- Meets the eligibility criteria and skills as outlined in the RFANS by-laws. **(see attached document).**
- Exhibit strong leadership, collaboration, and integrity.
- Can contribute meaningfully to the Recreation Facility Association of Nova Scotia.

Nomination Details: Nominations must be submitted in writing, together with a signed completed 2026 Board of Directors Nomination Application form (attached), cover letter indicating why the Nominee wishes to serve on the RFANS Board and the value/skills they

would bring to the Board and the organization, and a copy of their resumé, to the Nominating Committee by midnight **Tuesday, May 12th, 2026.**

Please note that individuals currently on the Board of Directors wishing to be re-elected are not subject to nomination but must notify the Nominating Committee twenty-eight (28) days before the election of their interest in re-election.
